A12 Planned Closure Update

Progress Update

We're writing to update you about our final phase of work on the A12 between junction 25 Marks Tey and junction 26 Stanway.

As we complete our final activities and work towards completion of the project, we wanted to make you aware that we have made some changes to our planned overnight road closures on both southbound and northbound carriageways.

Updated planned road closure dates to completion of the project


A list of our closure dates, which are subject to weather and progress, are listed in the table below:

Dates of closure	Closure details	Diversion Route
4 & 5 October 2024 Between 8pm and 6am each night	A12 closed northbound overnight between junction 25 Marks Tey and junction 26 Stanway for final surfacing and finishing work, and removal of cones and traffic barriers.	During these times, traffic will be diverted to exit the A12 via the junction 25 northbound exit slip road at Marks Tey; follow the signed diversion route along B1408 (London Road) to Stanway; re-join the A12 northbound via the Junction 26 northbound entry slip road.
5 October 2024 Between 8pm and 6am	A12 southbound exit slip road at junction 25 Marks Tey closed.	Traffic will be diverted to continue along the A12 southbound to junction 24, and re-join the A12 northbound via the J24 northbound entry slip road.


Full closure of the A12 northbound overnight A diversion will be in place between junction 23 from junction 19 via the A131. Kelvedon and junction 26 A120 and B1408, re-joining the Stanway A12 via the A12 junction 26 6 & 7 October 2024 northbound entry slip road. There will be a general Local traffic wishing to exit the traffic diversion in place Between 8pm and 6am A12 up to junction 23 will be from J19 northbound. each night able to access via the A12 until however, local traffic the full closure at junction 23 requiring access between Kelvedon J19 and J23 can continue along the A12 until the full closure point at J23.


Diversion route for A12 **northbound** overnight closure between junction 25 Marks Tey and junction 26 Stanway
