### 19/42 Matters raised by Residents

A resident reported that the crossroads at the village hall has limited vision and could be an accident blackspot. The Parish Clerk was actioned to contact Sonia Church at Highways to review line markings and to ascertain how many accidents had occurred in this area. CBC Dennis Willetts & CBC Brian Jarvis will bring it to the attention of the Highways Panel.

Fairmeads hedge (near pumpkin patch) – is an offence if vegetation overhangs the highways?? Doesn't matter whether it has a footpath outside property or not?? Look at county council map showing boundaries for highways – PC to look at maps. Check this one out on map.

Gate on playing field – Colchester Workhorse – supply and install £296.64 (pedestrian gate) Agreed by all.

Bus Service – resident has no transport – husband in a wheelchair – buses irregular – takes her 2and a half-hour - better on Sunday than weekend. Commercial service (Hedingham) during week – Essex County Council step in on Sunday and put more buses on – Hedingham don't wish to put these on – county council subsidise. Community Bus (door to door) – she already uses this.
